His tires of choice for this expedition were Mitas TERRA FORCE-EX XT Super Light (former XT-754) rear and TERRA FORCE-EF Super front.

Unfortunately, Simon Marčič had many technical issues with the motorcycle and could not finish the race.



January, February, and March came to an end, and here is a look back at what we have achieved in the last three months.


