ENDURO GP ROUND 1: GP OF PORTUGAL (Fafe, Portugal)

The 2025 EnduroGP season kicked off in Fafe, Portugal. Mitas is proud to be the main partner of the 2025 EnduroGP World Championship, demonstrating our commitment to supporting the sport and its athletes. Mitas riders showcased their skills: Kyron Bacon from MGR Kawasaki team dominated the Junior Overall and Junior 2 categories, taking 1st place in both races. In the women's category, Rachel Gutish secured 2nd place, Rosie Rowett finished 4th (both from RIEJU), and Vilde Marie Holt (KTM) took 6th place.

In the picturesque landscapes of Tuscany, the 101% IN MITAS VERITAS event offered a unique off-road experience. The event, supported by Mitas, provided riders with the opportunity to test their limits on a 160 km challenging route.
